SPIKE IT is an innovative new work by artist Jeannie Driver produced in partnership with business, organisations and office workers.

SPIKE IT places 6ft tall spike files into offices to raise awareness with office workers around issues of paper-work, flow and waste as well as acknowledgement of workplace emotions. Office workers spike their wastepaper. As this work continues paper accumulates on **SPIKE IT** creating a sculptural bar chart of office activity.

Locating **SPIKE IT** in the office encourages discussion and lateral thinking, stimulating exchanges of new ideas and methods as well as tangible visual benefits to all parties.



SPIKE IT is now seeking new partners to broaden the range of office locations and to contribute to a 'forest' of spikes for a major **SPIKE IT** exhibition.

SPIKE IT is tailored to the individual office. **SPIKE IT** is documented through a range of media including photography, webcams, CCTV footage, mobile video and film. Options are explored with managers and office workers to seek the most appropriate approach.

Costs are dependant on office location and the **SPIKE IT** package required. Locating a **SPIKE IT** in your office starts from as little as £300.

SPIKE IT partners gain many benefits in and out of the office. Including opportunities to purchase limited edition prints, place logo's within publicity material and inclusion in **SPIKE IT** exhibitions. Further partnerships are explored through Office Investigations.
